WINTER PARK is set at 12 going (7 adults, 3 kids, 2 students). The ski train leaves Ottumwa, Iowa on March 24 at 7pm and returns March 29 around 10am. Eight of us are on for overnight travel and set to arrive at Winter Park around 10:30 Monday morning. Some will be skiing on that Monday with a 4-day lift ticket @ \$331. Otherwise, it's 3 ski days on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday for a \$250 lift ticket. There's a deal for kids renting gear, with an adult getting the lift ticket w/children getting free rentals! Those of us on the train will need to be back at the station in Fraser at 4pm. We've got plenty of

others from parts unknown that are mixed in to get the group rate on lift tickets being arranged by Sitzmark Travel. AmTrak tickets are a bargain for Seniors & children. Train 5 going out, and Train 6 coming back. Lodging is booked for the 8 of us at Beaver Village, with Mihail's family staying slopeside at Zepher Mtn. Lodge. Book lodging on your own, but I can guide you thru Sitzmark's site to book a condo.
